ARTICLE 1: Amend the Water Enterprise Budget

To see if the Town will vote to amend the Water Enterprise Budget as voted at the Annual Town Meeting held on May 19, 2010 under Existing Debt \$580,892, Other Expenses \$664,900, and Anticipated Debt \$400,000, and in their place vote the following, Existing Debt \$370,718, Other Expenses \$711,741, Anticipated Debt \$0, for a Direct Water Enterprise Expense of \$1,567,389, and a Grand Total Water Enterprise Budget of \$2,029,201, or take any other action thereon.
