Katie Goldrick: Thank you for joining us for an emergency Board of Health meeting for the town of Holbrook. On the agenda is COVID-19 updates to include but not limited to emergency order discussions.

Kat Tribulski: I do know the last thing the CDC put out they said if you are making them, obviously there were some great examples of dish towels being used for no sew options, but if you are making them and you get to have a choice of fabrics hundred percent cotton is I guess the best recommendation. Preshrunk preferably because then you put it in the wash and you have a mask that is this big (indicating very small). So for people who are out there making it that was their latest recommendations.

Kat Tribulski: Second motion.


Katie Goldrick: All in favor to begin tomorrow morning the order of the Board of Health for the face coverings order. Both Katie and Kat agreed.
