

It is not too late to get vaccinated for the Flu!

Free Flu Clinic on Tuesday November 24, 2020 from 4:00PM-8:00PM

You are invited to participate in the Avon, Holbrook and Randolph Flu Clinic. The influenza vaccine will be available as an injection (shot) to all that are age five (5) and over and as a nasal spray to all that are age five (5) to eighteen (18) years of age. Also available are influenza vaccines specifically made for those that are age sixty-five (65) and over.

In order to get vaccinated, participants are required to bring their health insurance cards. This allows the town to be reimbursed for administering vaccine at no cost to the participant. All vaccines will be provided at the upcoming clinic on a first-come, first-serve basis. Residents without health insurance are still encouraged to attend and you will still be able to receive a flu shot at no charge.

Once you reach the parking lot for the Holbrook Middle High School, there will be signage in the parking lot directing you to the clinic entrance. Upon arrival you will be greeted by a Medical Reserve Corp volunteer. There will be Public Health Department staff and Medical Reserve Corps volunteers wearing colored vests to answer any of your questions. Families should stay together, and will be vaccinated together.

Although vaccination is the most effective way to prevent getting the flu, there are other methods that may also help you stay healthy. Wash your hands frequently. Cover your cough with a tissue or the inside of your elbow. Throw the tissue out afterward. Try to keep from touching your eyes and mouth with your hands. Stay home when you are sick. This will help prevent others from getting ill.
