Holbrook designated high risk -COVID-19 Community Level Data Map

October 29th 2020- “The Commonwealth is reporting enhanced community-level data on key COVID-19 metrics as part of the Baker-Polito Administration's efforts to partner with cities and towns to slow the spread of the virus.

Based on the average daily cases per 100,000 residents, each city or town has been designated as a higher risk (red), moderate risk (yellow), or lower risk (green) community. Communities with fewer than 5 cases are not given a designation”.

The Town of Holbrook has been raised to high risk again as have many other communities (red).

The Town of Holbrook as of 10/29/2020 has 15 active confirmed cases of COVID-19.

The Holbrook Board of Health strongly discourages traditional, door to door trick-or-treating this year. Residents should shut off their exterior entry lighting to reinforce this policy.

Should residents decide to take part in safer trick-or-treating, they could provide individually wrapped candies or goody bags at the end of their driveway or walkway for neighborhood children to take. We highly discourage large groups of trick-or-treaters and others from congregating in close proximity.

Stay home and refrain from Halloween activities, including handing out Halloween treats, if:

- you feel unwell;
- you have tested positive for COVID-19;
- you have been exposed to someone with COVID-19; or
- you have traveled to or from a state that is not classified as lower risk within the last 14 days. For more information on lower risk states, please see the state's COVID-19 Travel Order webpage.
