RECYCLING/TRASH

New **65 gallon recycle** carts and **35 gallon trash** carts are being delivered the week of Oct. 21st – Oct. 25th to residents who currently have the town trash service.

What to expect:

- Beginning the week of October 28th, we will be picking up trash and recycling weekly in the new recycling and trash carts.
- The yearly fee for trash will be \$280.00* billed quarterly on the water/sewer bill.
- **Holbrook Blue Pay-As-You-Throw Bags only need to be used when throwing additional trash outside the trash cart.**
- Carts need to be placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on the day of your regularly scheduled trash collection day.
- Place carts at end of driveway or property with arrows on the lid pointing toward the street.
- Cart lid should be closed and not be overflowing.
- If cart is lost or damaged, there is a charge of \$55.00/trash and \$75.00/recycle to purchase a new cart.

Single Stream "All In One" Recycling

Acceptable	Unacceptable
Glass	
Recycle clear, green and brown glass beverage containers only. Rinse then remove foil (if any) before putting glass containers in your recycling bin. You Do Not have to remove paper labels.	DO NOT recycle light bulbs, plate glass, tempered glass mirrors, ceramics, Pyrex or any glass that is not a container. Please DO NOT recycle broken glass.
Aluminum, Tin and Metal Cans	
Recycle all aluminum, tin and metal food and beverage cans. CLEAN ONLY! Remember many aluminum cans can be returned for deposit. Wash each item and place in recycling bin. You do not have to remove labels from your cans. To conserve space, you may crush your cans.	DO NOT recycle scrap metal, paint cans, automotive product cans, or food contaminated aluminum plates, pie tins or foil.
Plastic Containers #1-7	
Please rinse all containers. You don't have to remove paper labels. Recycle all milk and water jugs, soft drink bottles, as well as bleach, detergent & fabric softeners.	DO NOT recycle plastic wrap, plastic bags or containers not marked with a number from 1 to 7, such as motor oils, antifreeze or hazardous materials. NO PVC, foam cups or foam packing.
